

1.1 DALI standard

The DALI DSI is designed to control control gear with DALI standard IEC 60929 (DALI VO).

2. Common

Functional description


- The converter module converts DALI commands into DSI signal so that all DSI-based operating devices presently available, such as PCA ECO ballasts, TEL transformers or PHD phase dimmers, can be integrated in DALI lighting control systems.
- The DALI DSI operates whilst the programming mode equal to a PCA EXCEL one4all, i.e. the DALI DSI has its own address and can be assigned to groups and scenes.


3. Installation

- The DALI DSI can easily be installed into a luminaire or flush socket.
- The DALI DSI must not be connected to the mains. It is supplied directly via the DALI signal line.
- DALI signals are not SELV. Therefore the same procedures should be applied as working with mains voltage.
